WILMINGTON, N.C. (Jan. 7, 2008) – If you're going to mix anything with the world's finest single-malt whiskies, golf is not only acceptable, but preferred by many. And if you're going to choose only one place to experience such a concoction, many would vote for the western coast of Scotland, where distilleries nearly as old as the game itself provide an inviting 19th hole experience for a number of historic courses.

PerryGolf's recently announced Scottish Links and Single Malt Whisky tours for 2008 combine opportunities to play five rounds of golf with visits to working distilleries where the drink that gave the Whisky Coast its name is made and enjoyed.

Golf during the six-night tour is offered on the Ailsa Course (site of the 2009 British Open) at the Westin Turnberry Resort, the picturesque 12-hole Shiskine GC at unspoiled Blackwaterfoot, magnificent Machrihanish on the southern tip of the Mull of Kintyre and (two rounds) at The Machrie on the Isle of Islay, where Willie Campbell's original layout dates to 1891.

"Some would say the Scottish golf experience is as much about a properly aged whisky enjoyed after the round with friends – some of whom you may have just met – as it is the

golf itself,” said PerryGolf president Gordon Dalgleish, a native of Scotland. “Fortunately on this tour one doesn’t have to choose between the two.”
