Saturday, July 14

Arrive at Glasgow Airport to be met by PerryGolf personnel. Transfer on arrival to the Westin Turnberry Resort. (Transfer time 1hr 15mins).

Overnight: The Westin Turnberry Resort

Sunday, July 15



This morning golfers play the **Ailsa Course** at the Westin Turnberry Resort (www.turnberry.co.uk) Lying on a spectacular curve of rockbound coast in the southern reaches of Ayrshire and long regarded as one of the finest courses in the world. The Ailsa Course has been host to the British Open Championship on three occasions with Tom Watson, Greg Norman and Nick Price as winners. The British Open will once again return to Turnberry as venue for the 2009 Championships.

Non Golfers can take the optional morning tour to visit Culzean Castle. Converted by Robert Adam, who designed much of Edinburgh's New Town. He included a 'Roman' viaduct and Ruined Arch to add drama to this Italianate castle in its spectacular clifftop setting. It contains a fine collection of paintings and furniture, and a display of weapons in the Armoury. The Circular Saloon has a superb panoramic view over the Firth of Clyde and the beautiful Oval Staircase is Robert Adam's final masterpiece of interior design. In 1945 the top floor was given to General Eisenhower as a token of Scotland's recognition of his role during World War II. The Georgian Kitchen gives a glimpse of life below stairs 200 years ago. The Country Park contains miles of woodland walks and viewing many restored estate buildings, such as the Ruined Arch and Viaduct, beautiful Camellia House and unique Pagoda. The immaculate Garden areas include the terraced Fountain Court and the Walled Garden with its



redesigned pleasure garden and impressive reconstructed Victorian Vinery.

This afternoon transfer from Turnberry to the Clipper Adventurer at her berth in Greenock where embarkation will be available from 4:00pm. The journey will join the coastal route offering wonderful views over the Firth of Clyde to Arran, the Cumbraes and Bute before arriving in Greenock. (Transfer time 1hr 30mins).
