SUNDAY, 26 SEPTEMBER

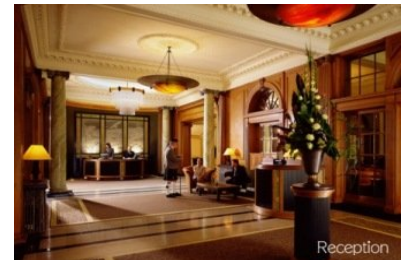
On arrival at Glasgow or Edinburgh Airport you will be met by PerryGolf personnel and transferred to **Gleneagles**. (1hr 10mins)

The remainder of the day will be at your leisure allowing time to relax and settle into your new surroundings. MONDAY, 27 SEPTEMBER

Following breakfast enjoy golf on the **King's Course at Gleneagles**.

The King's course was the inspiration of James Braid, five time winner of the Open championship. It opened in 1919, representing the finest 'classical' golf course design. Selecting the right club for each approach shot is the secret on the King's. It is certainly one of the most beautiful and exhilarating places to play golf in the world. With the springy moorland turf underfoot, the sweeping views from the tees all around, the rock-faced mountains to the north, the green hills to the south, and the peaks of the Trossachs and Ben Vorlich on the western horizon.

TUESDAY, 28 SEPTEMBER

Depart Gleneagles after breakfast and journey to Fife for golf at **Kingsbarns Golf Links**. (1hr 15mins)

The course officially opened in 2000 and has quickly been established as one of the finest links courses in Scotland. A challenging links experience awaits golfers as the course's spacious fairways roll and twist over dune ridges and hollows through Scottish heather and wispy rough along 1.5 miles of scenic coastline near St. Andrews. The main challenge is the vast and heavily contoured greens that require clever shotmaking on your approach otherwise you are looking at a three putt or worse.

WEDNESDAY, 29 SEPTEMBER

Following breakfast golf today is played over the **PGA Course at Gleneagles**.

The PGA Centenary Course, created by Jack Nicklaus, is a modern classic. It will host the 40th Ryder Cup Matches in 2014. The tees are graded at each hole in five stages, it can play long so choose your tees carefully. Fittingly, the PGA Centenary Course begins by playing southeast towards the glen, sweeping up the Ochil Hills to the summit of the pass below Ben Shee which joins it to Glendevon. A feature is the feast of views of the spectacular countryside in which Gleneagles is set. As with many Nicklaus Designs much of the trouble is short of the green, with deep bunkering and hazards a plenty.

Following golf transfer by motorcoach to Glasgow or Edinburgh Airport for your flight south to Wales for attendance at the Ryder Cup.

Upon arrival continue with onward travel by road to Newport and embark Le Diamant your base for the next five nights. Following check-in dinner will be served in the restaurant.

THURSDAY, 30 SEPTEMBER

Breakfast onboard Le Diamant then transfer from the ship towards Chepstow for golf at **St Pierre – Old Course (Morning Shotgun Start)**. Transfer 20 miles. (35mins)

The Old course occupies a mature, former deer park, opened for play in 1962, and was designed by C.K. Cotton. It was here, in the 1980 British Masters, that Bernhard Langer became the first German to win a major tournament. The 6,750-yard par 71 layout is certainly no pushover accurate positioning from the tees will pay dividends.

This afternoon the opportunity exists for all guests to attend the **Opening Ceremony of the Ryder Cup at Celtic Manor** when the players are introduced by their Team Captains, Corey Pavin and Colin Montgomerie.

Following the ceremonies return to the ship for Captains Cocktail Party and Dinner.

FRIDAY, 1 OCTOBER

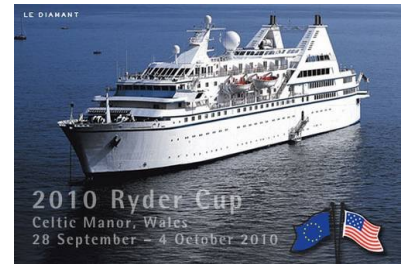
Transfer this morning from Le Diamant at Newport to Celtic Manor (7 miles) for attendance at the first day of the Ryder Cup Matches. This will be the 38th encounter for the Ryder Cup which was first played in 1927. Wales and Celtic Manor are proud hosts for the first time in the history of the event.

Multiple transfers will operate to and from the Ryder Cup Event. The transfer schedule will start early and finish late allowing flexibility in your day.

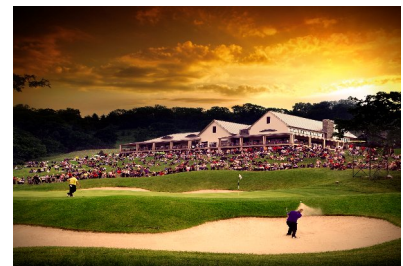
SATURDAY, 2 OCTOBER
