SATURDAY, 25 SEPTEMBER

This evening depart the United States

SUNDAY, 26 SEPTEMBER

On arrival at Glasgow Airport you will be met by PerryGolf personnel and transferred to **Turnberry** on the Ayrshire coast. (1hr 15mins)

The remainder of the day will be at your leisure allowing time to relax and settle into your new surroundings. Make use of the resort facilities. The spa offers a comprehensive selection of treatments aimed at creating mind-body harmony, and facilities includes a 65-foot glass-walled and heated indoor swimming pool, 12 serene treatment rooms, luxurious lounges for unwinding before and after a session, a Jacuzzi, sauna and steam rooms, and an adjoining fitness centre.

Take the opportunity to warm up for links golf at the Colin Montgomerie Golf Academy. With state-of-the-art facilities, including driving and pitching ranges, covered bays, simulators and swing analysers.

MONDAY, 27 SEPTEMBER

Following breakfast depart the hotel and transfer by motorcoach (45mins) for the first round of golf at **Western Gales**.

Located to the north of Troon on the Ayrshire coastline, this natural links course offers undulating fairways, occasionally interrupted by three meandering burns. It's setting is imposing being situated between the railway and the sea, both being very much in play as major features. The course is never other than an excellent test of true links golf. Any change in the strength or direction of the wind, that usually varies between south-westerly and north-westerly off the adjacent Firth of Clyde, provides new challenges that are compounded by the undulating terrain and finely contoured greens cleverly located and set in the folds of the surrounding sand dunes.

This evening you are free to dine on your own arrangements.

TUESDAY, 28 SEPTEMBER

Following breakfast depart the hotel and transfer by motorcoach (40mins) for golf at **Royal Troon Golf Club**.

Founded in March 1878, Troon is renowned worldwide as one of the very best links golf courses, and host to the Open Championship on no fewer than eight occasions, most recently when the unheralded Todd Hamilton triumphed in 2004 following a play off victory over Ernie Els. During its centenary year, Troon was honoured with the 'Royal' accolade, and remains the most recent club to be recognised as such. The Old Course is a classic Scottish links, with characteristic wind with which to contend, in addition to deep rough, broom and gorse. Scores are generally made on the front nine, because battling home after the turn against the prevailing wind is often a case of damage limitation. The par 3 8th, named the "Postage Stamp" is surely one of the most famous shots in golf. Standing on the tee with a strong cross-wind, the golfer is faced with a tiny green, flanked by cavernous pot bunkers.

WEDNESDAY, 29 SEPTEMBER

Following breakfast golf today is played over the **Ailsa Course at Turnberry.**

The Ailsa Course is currently ranked as Britain's number one golf course by two leading golf publications, and is consistently rated within the world's best. After heavy use as an airfield during the war, golf course architect, Mackenzie Ross, was commissioned to redesign the Ailsa and it re-opened as the links you can see today in 1951. It occupies a spectacular curve of rockbound coast in the southern reaches of Ayrshire. The coastal scenery is truly magnificent especially from the 4th through the 11th passing the famous landmark lighthouse at the turn. It is both spectacular and dramatic in every sense. Whether you're staring down the narrowest of fairways with bunkers either side, or contemplating a 200-yard carry over the rocks to reach a distant target, the course will favour those that make the right decisions in all conditions. In 2009, the Ailsa Course was again host to the Open Championship for the 4th time when golfing legend Tom Watson just fell at the last hurdle and subsequently lost out to Stewart Cink in a play off for the Claret Jug.

Following golf transfer by motorcoach to Glasgow Airport for your flight south to Wales for attendance at the Ryder Cup.

THURSDAY, 30 SEPTEMBER

Breakfast onboard Le Diamant then transfer from the ship towards Chepstow for golf at **St Pierre – Old Course (Morning Shotgun Start).** Transfer 20 miles. (35mins)

The Old course occupies a mature, former deer park, opened for play in 1962, and was designed by C.K. Cotton. It was here, in the 1980 British Masters, that Bernhard Langer became the first German to win a major tournament. The 6,750-yard par 71 layout is certainly no pushover



accurate positioning from the tees will pay dividends.

This afternoon the opportunity exists for all guests to attend the **Opening Ceremony of the Ryder Cup at Celtic Manor** when the players are introduced by their Team Captains, Corey Pavin and Colin Montgomerie.

Following the ceremonies return to the ship for Captains Cocktail Party and Dinner.

FRIDAY, 1 OCTOBER

Transfer this morning from Le Diamant at Newport to Celtic Manor (7 miles) for attendance at the first day of the Ryder Cup Matches. This will be the 38th encounter for the Ryder Cup which was first played in 1927. Wales and Celtic Manor are proud hosts for the first time in the history of the event.

Multiple transfers will operate to and from the Ryder Cup Event. The transfer schedule will start early and finish late allowing flexibility in your day.

SUNDAY, 3 OCTOBER

Transfer this morning from Le Diamant at Newport to Celtic Manor (7 miles) for attendance at the final day of the Ryder Cup Matches.

12 Singles Matches will be played during the day to decide the destination of the Ryder Cup.

Disembark Le Diamant this morning by 9:00am at latest for transfers or continue with onwards travel arrangements. (Tour costs exclude departure transfer).

The world renowned **Turnberry, A Luxury Collection Resort** overlooks Scotland's South West Ayrshire coast. Contained within 360 acres this luxury hotel, golf and leisure resort with few equals in the world.
