



THE 2009 BRITISH OPEN AT TURNBERRY BY LAND & SEA

16-19 JULY 2009

The Open Championship returns to the fabled Ailsa Course at the Westin Turnberry Resort 16-19 July 2009. This was the stage in 1977 for arguably the greatest 36 hole drama in major championship golf when Tom Watson's weekend of 65-65 clipped Jack Nicklaus' 65-66 for the Claret Jug.

Combining the Open with your schedule of legendary links golf is truly one of the most memorable experiences imaginable in Scotland. We have assembled what we believe you will find to be among the most entertaining options to enjoy the opportunity to its fullest.

The tenth sailing of our "British Open by Sea" golf cruise charter will visit Scotland's shoreline 11-20 July from St Andrews to Turnberry for eight nights and five rounds on board the 105-guest *Andrea*. Golfers will enjoy classic links including Kingsbarns, Royal Dornoch

and Machrihanish. Non Golfer touring includes the City of St Andrews, Crathes Castle & Gardens, single malt distilleries and Inverewe Gardens. *(See reverse side for day by day details.)*

A variety of land programs include your chance to step inside the ropes and experience The Open like a participant. Stay at Turnberry, play five rounds and use your Grounds Series ticket to check in on the tournament whenever you wish throughout the week. We also have packages at Marine Hotel in Troon, just 30 minutes north, offering a Grounds Series Ticket and six rounds including Royal Troon and Western Gailes. Better still, we are pleased to offer play on the Ailsa Course the day it reopens, providing you the chance to try your hand on a major championship set up.

7.11 UNITED STATES

This evening depart the United States.

7.12 EDINBURGH

Morning arrival at Edinburgh Airport to be met by PerryGolf personnel. Transfer to our early baggage check in. Explore Edinburgh at your leisure before embarking the *M/S Andrea* at Leith Docks at 4:00 pm.

Welcome cocktail party prior to dinner. Evening sail to Dundee.

7.13 DUNDEE

Golf at **Kingsbarns**. Touring passengers will enjoy a visit to St Andrews, one of the most historic towns of Scotland.

Evening sail to Aberdeen.

7.14 ABERDEEN

Golf at **Royal Aberdeen**. Touring will include the **Granite City of Aberdeen** plus an afternoon visit to **Crathes Castle and Gardens**.

Evening sail to Invergordon in the Highlands of Scotland.

7.15 INVERGORDON

Golf at **Royal Dornoch**. Visit **Glenmorangie Distillery** for a personally guided tour then the charming town of **Dornoch**.

Evening departure as *M/S Andrea* begins her sail of Scotland's northern shoreline.

7.16 INVEREWE

The *M/S Andrea* continues its journey through the Western Isles before arriving in Loch Ewe for a tour of **Inverewe Gardens** before lunch, after which we will continue sailing south along the dramatic western shores of Scotland.

Overnight sail to Campbeltown.

7.17 CAMPBELTOWN

Golf at **Machrihanish**. Touring guests will enjoy the day traveling the west and east shores of the **Kintyre Peninsula** including the quaint fishing village of **Tarbert** plus stops at **Carradale** and **Saddell Abbey**.

Early evening *M/S Andrea* makes the short crossing to Troon which will be her base for the British Open weekend.

7.18 TROON

Golf at **The Carrick on Loch Lomond**; one of Scotland's new classics with striking views over the loch. Touring takes in Glasgow including the Cathedral and the Burrell Collection, plus free time for shopping.

Overnight in Troon.

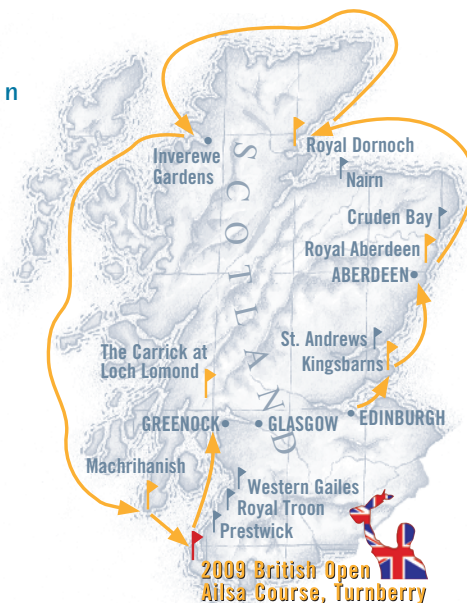
7.19 TURNBERRY

Today all passengers will attend the **Final Round of the 138th British Open Championship at Turnberry**.

Evening sail to Greenock to the West of Glasgow.

7.20 GREENOCK

Disembark *M/S Andrea*, transfer to Glasgow Airport for departing flights or onward travel arrangements.
