SUNDAY, 26 SEPTEMBER

Participants will make their way to Inverness where the Heritage Fourball will commence with a warm up round at nearby **Castle Stuart Golf Links**. Starting times for the practice round will commence around midday.

The newest addition to the Links Courses of Scotland. **Castle Stuart** runs along the shores of the Moray Firth to the east of Inverness with wonderful views over to the Black Isle. Six holes hug the shoreline while the remaining holes are played over a terraced slope so views out to sea are ever present. Designed by Mark Parsinen (Kingsbarns) and Gil Hanes, this is a true links course in every sense, with the Moray Firth brought into perspective as much as possible. Clever mounding ensures most holes are played in isolation from the rest. A specific feature prominent over the entire layout, is the use of expansive wild looking waste bunkering, which is also combined with strategic rivetted face bunkers give the course a wonderfully natural look.

Following golf you will have the opportunity to meet your fellow Heritage Fourball participants for a **Welcome Drinks Party** at Castle Stuart Golf Links occupying wonderful views over the Moray Firth.

Transfers will be available to return guests to the Kingsmills Hotel after the reception.

MONDAY, 27 SEPTEMBER

The first round of the Heritage Fourball will be played over **Royal Dornoch Golf Club**. Motorcoach transfers will operate from the hotel to golf (55mins journey time).

Royal Dornoch is the most northerly of the Championship courses of the British Isles. It is perhaps more than most, a thinking golfers' course where it is not enough simply to keep the ball on the fairway. The greens are generally open in the front, but they are also set on plateaux several feet above the fairway, a feature that Donald Ross took from his home course and used on many of his classic designs. Dornoch is far from the main centres of population nevertheless it has hosted through the years the Northern Open, the Scottish Ladies, Scottish Amateur and Scottish Professional Championships.

Lunch will be available in the clubhouse following golf before returning to the hotel late afternoon. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure.

TUESDAY, 28 SEPTEMBER

Competition continues with the second round played over **Nairn Golf Club**. Motorcoach transfers will operate from the hotel to golf (25mins journey time).

Founded in 1887, **Nairn** is consistently ranked one of the best courses in Scotland. A renowned links course that legendary Scots, Old Tom Morris and James Braid have had a hand in shaping. Nairn has played host to many major tournaments, including the 1993 British Amateur Championship, the 1999 Walker Cup Matches and is host venue to the 2012 Curtis Cup. This traditional links layout makes its way along the shores of the Moray Firth, then returns to the clubhouse through whin and gorse bushes which provide an ever present hazard.

Lunch will be available in the clubhouse following golf before returning to the hotel late afternoon.

This evening join your fellow Heritage Fourball competitors for dinner in Inverness. Transport will be available from the hotel to/from the restaurant.

WEDNESDAY, 29 SEPTEMBER

The destination of the Heritage Fourball will be decided with the final round played over **Castle Stuart Golf Links**. Shotgun Start. Motorcoach transfers will operate from the hotel to golf (15mins transfer time).

COMPETITION FORMAT

Each team to consist of 1 PGA Professional and 3 Amateurs. Maximum handicaps are Men 24 and Ladies 36. The format of the competition will be 54 holes strokeplay to be played over Nairn, Royal Dornoch and Castle Stuart. Two low scores to count at each hole. The Heritage Fourball Team Winners will be the lowest net score. There will also be Gross score and daily prizewinners as determined by the Advisory Board.

BOOKING INFORMATION

To confirm your Team's participation in the Heritage Fourball we require the attached Reservation Form completed along with a deposit of \$750 per amateur participant. This can be paid by credit card or US Dollar check. Balance payment will be required 60 days prior to departure.
