Saturday, June 1

Sunday, June 2

Make your way to your chosen golf course. 10 minutes

Today play **Castle Stuart (tbc)**. Opened for play in July 2009 and is an outstanding addition to the links courses of Scotland. Set along the shores of the Moray Firth to east of Inverness with wonderful views over to the Black Isle. Six holes hug the shoreline while the remaining holes are played over a terraced slope so views out to sea are ever present. A true links course in every sense.

Monday, June 3

Make your way to your chosen golf course. 1 hour

Golf today on **Royal Dornoch (tbc)**. You have the opportunity to play the most northerly of the Championship courses of the British Isles. Dornoch is perhaps more than most, a thinking golfer's course where it is not enough simply to keep the ball on the fairway. The greens are generally open in the front, but they are also set on plateaux several feet above the fairway, a feature that Donald Ross took from his home course and used on many of his classic designs.

A very limited supply of golf carts are available for hire. Certain restrictions may apply, please advise your Golf Travel Specialist. Please note strict handicap limits are set and enforced by the club. Men 24 & Ladies 35.

Tuesday, June 4

Make your way to your chosen golf course. 25 minutes

Play today at **Nairn (tbc)**, a renowned links course and venue of many major tournaments, including the 1993 British Amateur Championship and the 1999 Walker Cup Matches. This traditional links layout makes its way along the shore of the Moray Firth, then returns to the clubhouse through whin and gorse bushes.

Wednesday, June 5

Make your way to your chosen golf course. 3 hours 15 minutes

Today play **Carnoustie (tbc)**. With its thick rough and devilish bunkers, Carnoustie is known as one of the world's most challenging links courses and considered by many to be the most challenging of all Open venues. While the links is relatively flat it is exposed to the elements, a combination of length and accuracy are required from the tee to avoid the clever placement of the fairway bunkers and approach shots demand precision to greens heavily guarded by steep bunkers and burns. Arguably the toughest and most memorable finishing holes in championship golf. A state of the art clubhouse facility was completed in time for the 2018 Open Championship, containing seven Foresight simulators and the excellent Rookery Restaurant with panoramic views of the golf courses and the sea.

Golf today on **Muirfield (tbc)**, home of the Honourable Company of Edinburgh Golfers, and consistently ranked as Scotland's finest course. The course of today was laid out by Harry Colt. The clockwise front nine envelopes the anti-clockwise back nine creating the ultimate layout which causes you to play in a variety of wind directions. The Open Championship was held at Muirfield for the 16th time in 2013 when Phil Mickelson claimed the Claret Jug. Please note strict handicap limits are set by the club. Men & Ladies 18.

Friday, June 7

Play today at **North Berwick (tbc)**. Like St.Andrews the links starts and finishes in the town. One of Scotland's earliest golf clubs and correspondingly a very traditional links layout. The West Course requires unusual shotmaking, along with blind shots and play over stone dykes. Features the par 3, 15th 'Redan' which is probably the most frequently copied short hole in the world. Entered into the Top 100 Courses in the World in the 2007 Rankings.
