Rated number 16 in Australia it has hosted the Australian Open. Commonwealth features all the good facets of the Sand Belt courses, fast greens, exceptional bunkering and beautiful flora. Probably most important about this course is that having played it, you feel that you have just enjoyed a wonderful experience.

Today play **Royal Melbourne West Course (tbc)**. Continually rated as the number 1 golf course in Australia and has been as high as number 5 in the world. It is the most recognised golf course on the world famous Melbourne Sandbelt. The site remains one of the finest ever found in world golf, full of dramatic undulation with fertile sandy soil and a natural rugged appearance. Designed by Dr Alister Mackenzie, the bunkering is spectacular while the rough areas around the tees and bunkers are a mix of native grasses which beautifully and naturally frame each hole, providing great definition and contrast without distracting from the strategy. The greens provide the finest putting surfaces in Australia. Large and beautifully contoured they are built to accommodate approaches from a number of angles with each progressively more difficult the further the tee shot strays from the perfect line.

Today play **Kingston Heath (tbc)**. Designed by Dr Alister MacKenzie and ranked number 2 in Australia is one of the greats in the world.
